Santosh Kumar Kalwar (Nepal Bhasa: सन्तोष कालवार) (born September 7, 1982) is a poet, writer and researcher. He is a self-published Nepalese writer who writes in English. Kalwar was born and raised in Chitwan, Nepal,^[1] and came to study in Finland at the age of twenty-five. He has authored a number of newspaper columns, articles and books on truth, love and relationships.^{[2] [3]}

Biography

Kalwar is a PhD Candidate at the Lappeenranta University of Technology, Lappeenranta, Finland.^[4] He has been selected as a graduate student to East Finland Graduate School (ECSE).^[5] His research area is in Human Computer Interaction.

He holds Master of Science in Information Technology degree from Lappeenranta University of Technology and Bachelor of Engineering in Computer Science and Engineering from Acharya Insitutie of Technology; Bangalore, India affiliated to Visvesvaraya Technological University, Belgaum.

His research has examined human anxiety on the Internet, service front-end for reducing human anxiety on Internet and understanding human behavior on the Internet.^{[6] [7]}

He is a member of IEEE and Association for Computing Machinery. He has worked as a trainee at the Office of the Chief Technology Officer (OCTO) at Nokia, Helsinki, Finland. The team worked on the idea to develop messaging-based services designed for millions of users. The principal research question was “how service concepts and technologies can scale up without a prohibitive increase in investment?” Nevertheless, he has also taught as an

assistant lecturer at Khowpa Engineering College, Kathmandu for about one semester.

In October, 2009, *Time* selected his question, "Why is it, do you think, that hips don't lie?"^[8] Kalwar is the winner of the first Book In Sync Poetry Contest with his poem "Gloomy Sunday".^[9]

Kalwar was invited for St. Joseph Party in Melk by Paulo Coelho for his active participation in Coelho's official blog.
